Learn how to treat children using *tui na* and other techniques with **Elisa Rossi**

This seminar will mainly be based on interaction and small groups, using problem-solving learning • We will look at physiology, aetiology, semeiotics and pathogenesis in children • Localisation and function of child-specific points, lines and areas • Specific paediatric *tui na* techniques • Diagnosis of the clinical pattern of the most common disorders (winter respiratory diseases, poor appetite, fever, gastrointestinal disorders, sleep troubles, hyperactivity, retarded psychophysical development) • Use of *guasha*, moxibustion, plum blossom needle and ear seeds • Discussion and choice of treatment sequences • Hints for teaching the sequences to parents • Case discussion or direct treatment of young patients • DVD on clinical practice at the Xiaoxiao Children's Centre

Elisa Rossi founded in 2002 and still runs Xiaoxiao – a free acupuncture and *tui na* children's centre in Milan. She has conducted two free pilot projects there, one for the prevention and treatment of winter respiratory diseases and one for hyperkinetic children.
